

## Some Friendly Reminders...

### SAFETY

- The speed limit on East Meadows roads is posted at 25 mph for the safety of the community. Please keep an eye on your speed throughout the resort.
- Workers must obey all stop signs and come to a complete stop before proceeding.
- Parking is prohibited on streets between Oct. 15<sup>th</sup> and May 15<sup>th</sup> to accommodate snow removal. Special road parking approval can sometimes be obtained by contacting the ACC Consultant. Parking is only allowed on the uphill side of the (if roadway parking is allowed in Contractor Constraints Agreement) street when these dates are not in effect. Never park on both sides of the street. Pick a side no matter where you are going to park and everyone park on that side! These policies will be enforced.
- No smoking is allowed, except in paved areas where the threat of fire is at a minimum.
- Dogs must be on a leash, on site with the owner, and under control at all times.
- Bears and other animals are present at Kirkwood and can be a nuisance and even dangerous. Please remove all edible garbage from your work site before you leave daily.
- No building materials are to be stored on the dirt or vegetation outside the clearly marked building/disturbed area boundaries.
- All BMP's must be in place and ready to reduce erosion before leaving the site on a daily basis no matter what the weather is. Thunderstorms and downpours come down quickly and sometimes without warning.
- Damage to the common areas and roadways will be charge back to the general contractor/owner on the job.

### COURTESY

- East Meadows construction hours are 7 AM – 7 PM. All noise should be kept to a minimum outside of these hours. Please remember that even slamming car doors can make a lot of noise at 6:30 AM.
- No trespassing is allowed on the properties surrounding your work site (without written approval of the owner). This includes walk-through paths and parking on neighboring lots or driveways.
- Please tread lightly to preserve Kirkwood's natural beauty. Avoid any damage to trees and surrounding growth.
- Everyone has different music tastes, so radio volumes should be kept at a minimum level at all times and not heard by properties next door.
- Please maintain the job site in a clean and safe manner on a daily basis. Your help in picking up trash, even if it isn't yours, is greatly appreciated and the rules!
